

Competition Rules:

- 1. Fishing is to take place in designated fishing areas (Local Balranald District). 16 km downstream to the low level weir and upstream to Glen Avon Bridge.
- 2. Bank fishing is allowed in designated areas.
- 3. Fishing times are strictly between 7am and 6pm Saturday and between 7am and 11am Sunday.
- 4. NO FISHING TO BE DONE outside these hours by competitors.
- 5. Fishing regulations apply, all competitors are to hold a valid and current NSW fishing licence. A limit of 2 rods and 2 hooks per person.
- 6. Only fish greater than minimum legal size should be measured to claim as a valid entry. ALL fish are **CATCH AND RELEASE ONLY.**
- 7. Non-native fish (carp) will be bagged and the largest length measured and sent in via text message entry. A raffle ticket per bag of carp entered. prize \$500.
- 8. Any competitor who is caught breaking the rules will be disqualified and no refund offered.
- 9. COMPETITION OFFICIALS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WARN OR DISQUALIFY ANY COMPETITOR DEEMED TO BE CREATING A NUISANCE EITHER AT THE CARAVAN PARK, ON THE WATER OR AT THE FOOTBALL COMPLEX.
- 10. Courtesy bus is available to commute competitors to and from the Balranald Football sheds for Saturday night meal and entertainment.
- 11. Under the circumstances of **no native fish** being caught, all competitors will go into the draw to win the cash prizes.
- 12. LIFE JACKETS: To be carried on board at all times. **Under 12 years** of age must have life jackets on at all times while in the boat plus the driver of the boat. If you're alone in the boat you must wear a life jacket at all times while in the boat.

Fish are photographed with competitors' mobile phones on a mat clearly showing a scaled measurement. The Competitor's card must be in the photograph on the brag mat and an additional photograph with the competitor holding the fish.



First Photo - Correctly positioned fish and competitor card on or near the fish.




Second Photo - holding fish (must be able to see the whole fish and competitor.
